PREFACE

This is the fourth annual Devon bibliography. It appears in 1985 rather than in 1984 because as a consequence of cuts in expenditure made by Devon County Council in the Library Services budget it has not been possible to obtain the slips from the West Country Studies Library on which the bulk of this bibliography is based as quickly as in the past. At the AGM of the Devon History Society a motion was passed unanimously drawing attention to this problem. This motion led to some examination of the library services but it would be optimistic to expect much in the way of improvement since support (obviously misguided in this respect as in others) for cuts on public expenditure is still considerable and there is no indication that the private sector has either the wish or resources to compensate. For the compilation of this bibliography we are again indebted above all to Ian Maxted, the West Country Studies Librarian, who supplied most of the entries, to Geoffrey Paley, who organised the material, and to Mrs Sigrid Drodge who typed the cards. James Gould was again responsible for the design.

This bibliography began as an attempt to keep the *Devon Union List* (University of Exeter, 1977) up-to-date but because the new annual bibliography took some time to organise there is a gap between the *DUL* entries which stop in 1975 and the first of the annual bibliographies which relate to 1980. There is then a four years gap (1976-9). For some time discussions have been going on not only to fill this gap but also to produce the annual bibliographies more quickly and more effectively (with place and topic indexes which are not now possible). It now seems likely that a computer-based project can be investigated and this could well lead to a continuing computer file of local publications located in the West Country Studies Library.

Considerable efforts have been made to ensure that no relevant publication has been overlooked but nevertheless we may not have been completely successful. We would therefore urge authors, printers, publishers and readers to draw any omissions to our attention. Please let Geoffrey Paley know at the Devon & Exeter Institution, 7 The Close, Exeter and, if possible not only for 1983 but also for the years to come, please deposit copies in the West Country Studies Library, Exeter Central Library or the Devon & Exeter Institution. We would be very interested to learn if readers find this publication useful; could you kindly let us know?

A major problem relating to the publication of this *Annual Bibliography* is the lack of interest shown in it. Despite appeals, we do not get any indication that the *Annual Bibliography* is noticed let alone valued by members of the Devon History Society. A proposal that the publication of this *Bibliography* should be stopped has been rejected by the officers. Could I however suggest to some of those who actually read this preface that they might like to let the compilers know that their hard work is appreciated. This will encourage them to continue to compile this *Bibliography*.

This is the sixth volume in a continuing series of *The Mineral Statistics of the United Kingdom 1845-1913* and begins the coverage of the South West Peninsula. Devon and Somerset mines are less well known than their Cornish neighbours but they had a continuous history lasting two thousand years and included some of the world's biggest producers. This volume looks at the last years of the industry, tracing its decline from a high point in the mid-nineteenth century to near extinction in the years immediately preceding the First World War. Bringing together official government returns of production, ownership, management and employment, it provides basic information of all of the mines working in the district during this period. The addition of new locational information in the form of Ordnance Survey Grid References makes this the most comprehensive field guide to the still substantial surface and underground remains of both counties.
